We pause in a spirit of prayerful praise and thanksgiving unto God for the many opportunities we have been provided by God to share in outreach ministry! Indeed, 2011 has been a very active year for the Ely U.M.C. with regards to looking beyond ourselves. We continue to have an amazing “Prayer Shawl Ministry” which touches many lives beyond our church walls because of the great dedication and effort on the part of those who coordinate and lead this valuable aspect of our ministry with God and for God’s children. We continue to celebrate the work of the “Hearts 2 Hands” quilting group of our Church Family who make quilts for kids who are at risk. We give thanks for all those who are dedicated to sharing in our “Parish Nurse Ministry” as we seek to look beyond the gathered community of Sunday morning worshippers. “Stanley the Scare Crow” helped us raise over \$700.00 for our Ely Area Food Shelf during our October drive, a great year for “Stanley” as we reached out to others. As we continue to look beyond our

own walls we can include ministries like, participating in community wide efforts to provide worship services to those who can no longer gather in our church facilities by providing worship experiences at both the “Boundary Waters Care Center” and at “Ely carefree Living”, an Ecumenical Lenten Supper Ministry, “The Giving Tree Ministry” in connection with the Ely Community Resources Team, during this last year a senior exercise program in connection with the “Northwoods Hospice Respite Partners”, Young Life, and Children’s International. Yes, 2011 has been a very big year for the Ely U.M.C. as we have participated in looking beyond the walls of our church building here at the Ely U.M.C.!
