Indeed, we have been provided a wealth of opportunities for being in ministry with <u>GOD</u>; we have been provided opportunities to reach out in service, we have been provided opportunities to grow in our walk with God, we have been provided opportunities to worship our gracious and loving God, and we have been provided opportunities to be the Family of God as we seek to support one another as the Family of God, let us <u>REJOICE</u> in the many rich opportunities our gracious and loving <u>GOD</u> has provided us during 2015!!!

One of our long standing ministries with God is our "Parish Health Ministry" Team. Our "Parish Health Ministry" Team has continued through the years to be in ministry through a monthly Blood Pressure Program, visitation to members in the hospital and those who do not get out very much, a Pocket Cross Ministry, and a Prayer Shawl Ministry to name a few of the ways they are reaching out in service. New this year, the "Parish Health Ministry" Team started a Program which is called the "File of Life, this is a record or file for quick reference useful for to those responding to medical emergencies. The file is a summary collection of medical information. Our team has given out over 1000 of these "Files of Life" in and around the Ely area.

Another of our long standing ministries with God is our "Hearts 2 Hands" Quilting Group who makes quilts for "Kids at Risk". Our "Hearts 2 Hands" Quilting Group has been working together for roughly 12 years now and has just gone through a transitional stage with group membership. We joyfully celebrate the strength of this group as it has successfully transitioned and continues to be in ministry with God. During this group's 12 years in service it has made roughly 270 quilts. A secondary project under taken by the "Hearts 2 Hands" Quilting Group is the "Con-Kerr Cancer" Pillowcase Project, this year our group made 87 pillowcases in a one day blitz, awesome work.

Two other ministries which we have participated in during 2015 as we seek to be in service includes, the "Boundary Waters Care Center" Worship Services and the "Care Free Living "Worship Services. These two worship services are held for brothers and sisters in the Family of God living within our community who can no longer easily get to the churches within our community. Our Ely U.M.C. participates in bringing worship services to these facilities so those living in these facilities have the opportunity to worship as the Family of God.

Another of our long standing ministries is in connection with "Children's International" and our sponsorship of a girl from Guatemala named Evelin Sarai Jiatz Cotzal.

Also during 2015 we participated in Ely's "Relay for Life" Cancer Walk. Our Team the "M & M'S" or the "Methodist Milers" logged the most laps and raised the most money for cancer at the 2015 "Relay for Life" in Ely. We were able to bring in over \$7,000.00 as a team, awesome!!!

The second class, is for our very young children and has been ably coordinated by Devon Luthens and Jan Rue. The third class, is our before worship time of reflection on the Scripture Reading for the upcoming morning worship. This class is in its' second year and continues to have good attendance and valuable participation.

2015 has also seen our Youth Group continue to bloom through the leadership of Sheri Rue and Keith Rue. What a joy to see the commitment made by our young people to meeting together on a weekly basis during the school year. They also led two worship services during 2015, awesome.

Bible Study continues to meet on Thursdays during the school year with many rich opportunities for sharing, learning, and growing, as we focus on various Scriptural Topics sharing our thoughts and ideas in an atmosphere of caring for one another. What a blessing this Bible Study group is to each of those who invests their time and energy to this opportunity to grow in relationship with God and with each other, awesome.

Guild, the Women's Group who fellowship and study together provide yet another opportunity for our Church Family members, at least the women, to grow in their walk with God and with each other. During 2015 we have also sought greater participation by the Laity through their reading of the Scriptures for the morning worship service.
