March 18, 2015

President Jay Tomlinson called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Pastor Dana Thompson provided the "Opening Thought" from Jimmy Houston's "Hooked For Life", about how a map can not catch fish, but can help lead you to fish and the Bible can not save you but can help lead you to being saved. The "Opening Thought" was followed by prayer.

The Minutes of the February 18, 2015 Ad Council meeting; as printed in the March 2015 issue of "'*The Fish*" newsletter. A motion to accept as printed by Margie Olson, 2nd by Jeanne Tomlinson was passed unanimously.

The <u>Treasurer's Report</u> for February 2015 was presented and highlighted by Treasurer Mark Olson. The February end of the month account balances – Building Fund: \$ 21,591.86, Memorial Fund: \$ 11,052.95; Parish Health Ministries \$516.66; Reach, Renew, Rejoice \$1,100.00; Zach Dean \$675.00; Undesignated Funds \$ 3,000; General Fund: \$1,895.12. Mark pointed out that the February income reported included Pasties monies from both January and February and a \$2,000 transfer from the Undesignated Fund approved at the February Ad Council meeting. He also pointed out that the percentage of Pasties net income going to the General Fund is 60%.

- 2. **Reach, Renew, Rejoice** \$25 was received in February to move the total received to date: \$1,125. The Board felt that no funds should be sent until the end of the year when \$2,020 of the total would be sent with any balance carried forward to the following year's commitment.

1. Movie Day: The Visioning Committee will be hosting a movie day on April 12th as part of our Outreach for all church members and the Ely community. The movie is *God Is Not Dead*. The viewing permit of \$85 has been paid from the Outreach budget and the Ely Echo is donating ad space for 2 weeks. Northland Market will be donating refreshments and drinks for the event.
