LOVE OFFERING – MAY 17, 2015

Each year, churches of the MN Annual Conference take a Love Offering for Missions. The 2015 Love Offering will go to three projects that will advance our theme "God's Vision, Our Mission—Unleashed."

Grace Children's Center in Vietnam will receive 60% of the offering. This center is located in Ho Chi Minh City and is currently providing education and day care for young children. Currently there is one teacher who volunteers her time. The children learn to grow fruit, raise chickens and ducks, and make hats---all of which is sold to help support the school. The Love Offering would pay off a \$10,000 loan on the building, hire additional teachers and buy sewing machines.

Thirty (30)% of the offering will be used for grants that help churches form partnerships with local schools. This summer, churches will be invited to apply for up to\$1,200 to help them form school relationships. A few of the possibilities might be supplying backpacks, clothing, or weekend meals.

The last 10% will go to Volunteer in Mission Scholarships. That program enables teams to work on mission projects domestically and abroad. As you pray about these mission opportunities, please consider making a donation as you are able.
